On the other hand, you'll be more dependent on powered sites to keep the AC going or generators to keep cool



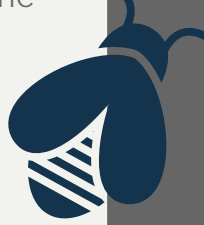
PRO: ADVENTURE SPORTS

The creepy crawlies love to come out to play and the humidity and hot nights does not exactly make for a romantic getaway!

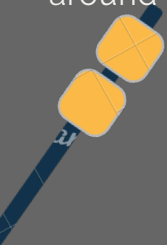


Pros and Cons to WINTER CAMPING

There is something special about cosying up around a fire with a hot cuppa and toasting some marshmallows



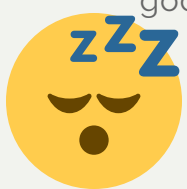
CON: UNPREDICTABLE WEATHER
